

<input type="checkbox"/> Symptom	<p>Acrobat Reader DC prints streaks (black bands or lines) instead of text after upgrading to Windows 10 Anniversary update. (Impacted version: Acrobat Reader DC Continuous only)</p> 
<input type="checkbox"/> Cause	<p>Adobe is aware of this problem, and working to fix it in a future release. https://helpx.adobe.com/acrobat/kb/reader-dc-prints-streaks-after-upgrade-Win10-anniversary-update.html</p>
<input type="checkbox"/> Solution	<p>Adjust the registry as a workaround</p> <p>Disclaimer: The registry contains system-related information that is critical to your computer and applications.
